

Alphabet Treasure Activity Card

This will test your child's understanding of letters and sounds using a variety of object to sort and categorise, all the while learning to be patient and to take turns.





WHAT DO I NEED

- 1. Empty boxes that are big enough to hold objects i.e. a shoe box
- 2. Pieces of card with letters of the alphabet on these could perhaps be the letters of your child's name
- 3. A bag containing objects with initial sound that match the alphabet cards you created
- 4. Glue

METHOD

- 1. Glue one letter on the side/top of each box and ask your child if they recognise each letter
- 2. Hold the bag containing the objects and ask your child to take an object from the bag
- 3. Encourage your child to identify the initial sound in the word and place it in the box labelled with the matching letter i.e. putting a ball in the box labelled with the letter B
- 4. Now it's your child's turn to hold the bag for you to select an object

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
