This game will encourage your child to interact with others as well as developing their memory, mathematics and concentration skills.


## WHAT DO I NEED

1. A large tray
2. A tea towel or small blanket
3.4 pieces of paper with the words red, yellow, green and blue (written in the corresponding colours i.e the word red should be written in red pen)
3. A bag or pillow case to collect objects

## METHOD

1. Place the card face down on the floor or table.
2. Ask your child to select a card, turn it over and identify the colour written.
3. Encourage your child to then go on a colour hunt around your home to find up to five objects that are the same colour as the card they selected, these objects can then be placed in their bag.
4. Place the objects on the tray, naming them as you do so, and ask your child to look at them carefully, so they can remember what is on the tray.
5. Cover the tray with the tea towel.
6. Place your hand under the towel and remove an object without your child seeing which one.
7. Remove the towel and ask your child to tell you which object is missing.
8. Now it is your child's turn to remove an object from the tray to see if you can recall which is missing.

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
