

Counting Game Activity Card

This activity will support your child to count and recognise numbers. It will support their understanding of one to one correspondence which is the ability to match an object to a corresponding number and recognise that numbers are symbols that represent a quantity.

WHAT DO I NEED

- 1. Various small items (these can be small toys or natural objects like stones, fir cones)
- 2. Containers (boxes/ bowls or egg boxes)
- 3. Tweezers/spoons/scoops
- 4. Paper/card
- 5. Pencils/pens
- 6.Dice

METHOD

- 1. Collect various items from around the house and/or garden
- 2. Encourage your child to number the containers
- 3. Support your child to put the containers in numerical order
- 4. Ask your child to use the tweezers, spoon or scoop to put the correct amount of items in each container
- 5. You could add a dice to the game. Encourage your child to roll the dice and collect the amount of items that correspond to the number on the dice

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
