

Growing Beans in a Bag Activity Card

Show your child the full life cycle of plants before their very eyes, from small beans to plants that then grow more beans!



WHAT DO I NEED

- 1. Dried beans
- 2. Clear zip lock bag
- 3. Kitchen towel
- 4. Sellotape

METHOD

- 1. Encourage your child to open the zip lock bag and place a piece of damp kitchen towel inside
- 2. Place several dried beans onto the damp kitchen roll
- 3. Seal the zip lock bag, this can then be taped onto a widow, so your child can observe the seeds spout and grow into a plant with roots. Your child could record their observations by drawing or taking a picture of what they see
- 4. Remember to ask open ended questions such as, "tell me about what you can see?
- 5. When the seeds have sprouted, and leaves start to emerge the beans are ready to be transferred to a small plant pot filled with soil so your child can continue to watch them grow.
